Who Is Eligible To Apply?

CDR's Youth Transition Project is open to young folks with disabilities between 16-24 who live or go to school in Old Saybrook, Old Lyme, Deep River, Essex, Chester, Haddam, Killingworth, Westbrook, Clinton, Madison, and Guilford. Young adults living in East Haddam, Middletown, Portland, and Durham will be accepted if spots are available.

Why Should I Apply?

CDR's Transition Advocates can help you to navigate and explore your options for school, work, and independent living. It is your life, and you decide how you want to live it. CDR just helps you to learn how to take control of your destiny and set goals for yourself. CDR will also help you to know what resources are in your community to help you to make your dreams a reality.

All successful applicants who participate in the Project will be guaranteed a \$1000.00 scholarship grant to use as you see fit to further your education.
