Dear Potential Participant, Educator, or Parent:

We are pleased to announce the 2016 Scholarship Summer Camps for High School juniors and seniors with disabilities.

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until the spots are filled. If you are interested, please do apply soon as each camp is limited to 5 participants.

The first camp will take place in Clinton, CT at our classroom at 36 Killingworth Tpke, Clinton (one block north of the Clinton Crossing Mall). The first three days we will offer workshops on self-advocacy skills; pre-employment skills such as interviewing and knowing your rights as an employee with disabilities; and Fundamentals of the Americans with Disabilities Act. All will be offered in a fun way, and lunch will be provided. Then the last two days (weather permitting) we will be at Hamonnaset State Park where we will apply the ADA concepts and standards that we have learned as we do field assessments of the accessibility of the Park.

The second camp will take place in West Haven at our classroom at 369 Highland Street. It will follow the same format as the Clinton camp, but the last two days will be on the Savin Rock boardwalk & beach.

Participants are to choose one camp to attend. Full attendance is required to earn the \$750.00 award. Also required is attendance at the 2016 Wheel-A-Thon event on July 26 at the Savin Rock Conference Center, West Haven from 6-8:30 PM. This is the event that raises the money for our Youth Programs and Scholarships, and the awards will be presented then.

The Scholarship awards may be used for post secondary education OR for expenses connected with living an independent life with a disability. Even if

the participant has no plans to attend school after High School; he/she is still eligible.

Applications will be accepted up until the Thursday before each camp starts (Thursday, June 23rd for Clinton, and Thursday, July 14th for West Haven). But do not wait to apply as space is limited.
