2017 Summer Internship Application

Description of Program: Center for Disability Rights offers opportunities for summer internships for high school seniors and college students up to age 21. All applicants must have one of more significant disabilities. The specific internship opportunity offered varies from year to year. This year we are offering two opportunities: Wheel-A-Thon 2017 Internship; and Consumer Satisfaction Survey Internship.

Wheel-A-Thon 2017 Internship: This internship will start on June 15th and end on July 27th, 2017. The internship will require approximately 12 hours per week, but ranges from 6 hours in June to 18 hours in July. Qualified candidates will possess good written and oral communication skills, and have planning and logistics capabilities. Intern will be responsible for developing and maintaining databases of WAT participants and sponsors, and coordinating registration efforts.

Consumer Satisfaction Survey Intern: This two week internship will start on July 31st and end on August 11th. Qualified applicants will have familiarity with MS Word or Apple Pages and Excel or Numbers. Must have the ability to make around 150 phone calls over the two week period. Intern is responsible for surveying the consumer satisfaction of CDR consumers who were active between March 1 and June 30th.
